

ITOBA's Stallion Seasons Auction: Part Two

"Buy It Now" Terms and Conditions

ITOBA is offering stallion seasons online at www.stallionticker.com on a "buy it now" basis, as Part Two of our 2009 Stallion Seasons Auction. You may register and secure a season online through the Stallion Ticker web site, or by voicemail by calling 800-450-9895 and pressing "1." Seasons will be sold for the listed price on a first come, first served basis.

The following terms and conditions apply to all purchases made through ITOBA's Stallion Seasons Auction. Please read all terms and conditions carefully. All season purchasers are responsible for understanding these terms and conditions and for complying with them in full. If you do not understand these terms and conditions, it is your responsibility to clarify any questions or concerns with an ITOBA representative prior to purchasing a season.

1. Do not make a bid that you are unwilling to honor. All bids are considered legally binding contracts, and if you bid your intent to purchase a season, you will be responsible for paying the listed amount to ITOBA immediately upon notification that you have secured that season.
2. If you currently have outstanding unpaid invoices with ITOBA, you are ineligible to participate in this or any future ITOBA sponsored events until your account has been settled.
3. If you are a non-ITOBA member and you secure one or more seasons, there will be a surcharge of \$50.00 added to your total due. This surcharge will include an ITOBA membership, good through the end of 2009. Additional surcharges will not be charged for multiple purchases. **This surcharge does not apply to current ITOBA members.**
4. A Return Privilege Season (RP) for the purposes of this auction means that if your mare does not produce a live foal from the purchased season in 2010, you will be entitled to return your mare (or a substitute mare which must be approved by the stallion season donator in the case of your mare's death or vet certified breeding unsoundness) in 2010 to be rebred with no additional stud fees due. A No Return Privilege Season (NRP) does not allow for a return in 2010. Check each season listing carefully to determine RP/NRP status.
5. If you are unable to breed your mare because the stallion you purchased a season to is sold, dies, or otherwise becomes unable to breed during the time allowed as per these terms and conditions, you may apply any monies paid for that season toward any other available season. **No refunds will be issued.**
6. All offspring of stallions with listed seasons are eligible for the ITOBA Stakes Bonus Program **providing that the stallion's season meets the program's selling requirements.** All nomination fees are the responsibility of the owner of the foal, and it is the foal owner's responsibility to become familiar with the rules and requirements pertaining to the program. 7. All purchasers of seasons to stallions standing in Kentucky will be charged Kentucky Sales Tax at the rate of 6% of the purchase price. This sales tax applies to every season sold for stallions standing in the State of Kentucky, and must be remitted to ITOBA with the payment for the season.
